From Nimpkish Heights road (not permitted in residential areas) across Hwy 19 to the gas station on Hyde Creek rd.

On Mine road from East Main to Campbell Way, across Campbell Way to gas station.

**Conditions 1-3 are for the purpose of obtaining food, fuel, and accommodations. Must comply with all regulations of the BC MVA and BC MVA Regulations. Speed is to be 15km/h or less on the shoulder of the roadway where possible.*
